Croser 'Adelaide Hills' Sparkling, Petaluma Adelaide Hills, Australia

£6.00

Petaluma Croser sparkling wine is a truly awesome sparkling wine. A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, the Chardonnay offers nectarine, cashews and biscuity characters with the Pinot Noir providing a fine mousse and strawberry fruit lift. Incredibly bubbly, with a long-lasting dry finish.

Cuvée Royale Brut, Champagne Joseph Perrier, Champagne, France

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut NV oozes classical Champagne elegance, composing of a blend of 35% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir and 30% Pinot Meunier, this shows bright and expressive fruits; apple, pear and citrus with a honeyed and brioche finish.

Rose75ml125ml175ml2022 Cotes de Provence Rose 'Préférences', Domaine des Mapliers, France£3.50£5.30£7.00

A blend of Grenache and Cinsault, this wine delivers a simple yet precise bouquet of fresh raspberries and vine peach. Superbly refreshing and delicate, the palate is charming and ethereal.

2022 Blanc de Malbec, Andeluna, Uco Valley, Argentina

£3.10 £4.65 £6.00

White Malbec - who knew?! Refreshing with an elegant floral character, hints of jasmine and white rose that lead to a delicately fruity palate of peach and apricot with a crisp, floral finish.

2022 Sauvignon Blanc, Ben Glover, Marlborough, New Zealand

£3.40 £5.10 £6.50

This stunning wine is made by one of the top New Zealand's top wine makers, Ben Glover and is an homage to his late sister, Kate. There are lovely aromas of white peach, melon and tropical fruits. Wonderful tastes of tropical passion fruit, guava and mandarin on the palate as well as a mouth-watering succulence and a delightful persistence.

2020 Estate Riesling, Frankland Estate, Frankland River, Australia

£3.30 £5.25 £7.00

The wine leaps out of the glass with perfumed white citrus florals, spice and grapefruit. A real generosity and poise on the palate. Ripe juicy limes upfront, with a crisp acidity that carries the fruit all the way into a long saline, mineral finish. Elegant yet powerful, it builds layers in the mouth as the wine opens up.

2020 Muscadet Les 'Gras Moutons', Domaine Haute Fevrie, Loire, France £3.90 £5.95 £7.50 Domaine la Haut Fevrie is one of the leading producers in Muscadet Sever et Maine. The palate is full bodied but with a lovely tangy fresh acidity and a beautiful minerality.

2021 Pinot Grigio, Elena Walch, Trentino Alto Adige, Italy

£3.90 £5.95 £7.50

Pinot Grigio but not as we know it! Elena Walch's Pinot Grigio captivates with a light straw yellow colour and fruity notes of ripe pears, white pepper and a bit of sage in the nose. Mineral- salty richness and a crisp acidity are distinctive on the palate. A wine with backbone!

2019 Chardonnay, Isabel Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand

£4.15 £6.30 £8.00

In the glass this 2019 Chardonnay delivers an intensely concentrated wine of elegance, complexity, depth and class. Characters of white nectarine complemented by intriguing gun smoke and flint, vanilla bean and French oak toastiness will delight even the fussiest of Chardonnay devotees.

2022 Malagousia, Ktima Gerovassiliou, Epanomi, Macedonia, Greece

£4.60 £6.95 £9.00

Expressive aromas of white pear, peach and lemon zest combine with floral hints. Opulent, with harmonious balance the palate offers a spicy, fresh and mouthwatering finish enveloped in a delicious flinty, mineral character.

2020 Chardonnay, Lismore, Overberg, South Africa

£6.25 £9.50 £12.00

The 2020 Lismore Chardonnay is delicious in the glass. The nose is a complex, expressive bouquet of citrus and tropical fruits layered with brioche, honey and walnut. The palate is carried through by a distinct minerality and crisp acidity through to a lingering citrus finish.



Wines by the Glass

Red 75ml 125ml 175ml

2020 Vinhos Rochas, Baleia, Western Cape, South Africa

£2.60 £3.90 £5.00

Wine from Rock – Made from Tempranillo and Syrah grapes grown in pure limestone soils, that are so hard and rocky that the vine struggles to grow and thus yields a small, concentrated crop. Baleia use amphorae to ferment the wine which highlights the unique minerality and makes for a tantalizing wine bursting with character.

2018 Chateau Fayau, Bordeaux, France

£2.75 £4.10 £5.25

This fantastically modern and versatile Bordeaux has delicate aromas of crunchy blackcurrant leading to a rounded palate with supple tannins and pleasant aromatic freshness.

2020 Mongrana, Querciabella, Tuscany, Italy

£3.30 £5.00 £6.50

A blend of Sangiovese (50%), Cabernet Sauvignon (25%) and Merlot (25%) Querciabella's Mongrana is the quintessential expression of the colours, sights and sounds of the Maremma region: fruity and intense, fresh and embracing.

2021 Paper Road Pinot Noir, Paddy Borthwick, Wairarapa, New Zealand £3.50 £5.30 £7.00 This wine is all about the purity of Pinot Noir with spicy savoury and bright, juicy red florals and fruits. It is medium-bodied with soft velvety tannins, a mix of tart and sweet cherry fruit with a chocolate touch to the lightly oaked finish and a spicy zestiness to the lingering aftertaste.

2019 Cabernet Sauvignon, Thabilk, Victoria, Australia

£4.15 £6.30 £8.00

This wine offers up red to black currant scents infused with black olive and dried herbs followed by some earthy tobacco and stalky cedar notes. Medium-bodied the palate has an even spread of blackcurrant and liquorice fruit underscored by toasty cedar, earth, subtle black olive and spicy dried herbs.

2018 Malbec 'Los Remolinos Vineyard', Finca Decero, Mendoza, Argentina £4.40 £6.70 £8.50 The Decero Malbec displays intense violet aromas over a core of red fruits with notes of cherries and raspberries. Rich in body and very well balanced with fresh acidity, it shows supple and elegant tannins that benefit from 14 months of maturation in French oak barrels.

2019 La Montesa Crianza, Palacios Remondo, Rioja, Spain

£4.40 £6.70 £8.50

This 2019 La Montesa Crianza is made from Garnacha and a small amount of Tempranillo, it is incredibly well-balanced with velvety red-fruit notes and hints of sweet spice, orange peel and dulcet yellow peaches found both in the nose and on the palate. An exceptional, Mediterranean Garnacha-based wine that excels with every vintage.

2020 Bishop Shiraz, Glaetzer, Barossa Valley, Australia

£6.00 £9.10 £11.50

Bishop is a true expression of Barossa Shiraz that is elegantly structured with a long finish. Made from exceptional old vine fruit was sourced from the famed Ebenezer sub district at the northern tip of the Barossa Valley. These old vines are upto 120 years old.

2021 Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine de la Solitude, Rhône Valley, France £6.50 £9.95 £12.50 Rich, smooth and flavoursome with complex layers of black-berried fruit, brambly notes, a touch of the local wild garrigue and gentle spice. Elegant yet sumptuous.

2019 Barolo, Giacomo Fenocchio, Piemonte, Italy

£8.20 £12.50 £16.00

The Giacoma Fenocchio Barolo DOCG is 100% Nebbiolo sourced from twenty year old vines planted in the Monteforte d'Alba region. Deep ruby red in colour with lively, bright highlights this red wine has an intense, ethereal bouquet, with flavours of liquorice and wild rose alongside warm and spicy aromas.

Port75ml125mlAlta No. 10' Ten-Year-Old Tawny Port, Quinta da Pedra Alta£5.00£8.00

Alta No.10 is an elegant, luscious, complex Tawny Port made in traditional granite lagars and aged in old casks. Great with cheese!
