Sparkling 125 ml

Prosecco Superiore Docg Conegliano-Valdobbiadene Brut, La Cantina Pizzolato £7.00

Pizzolato are an exceptional, forward-thinking winery based in the heart of the Conegliano-Valdobbiaddene hills, the classified region Prosecco Superiore D.O.C.G (you know the posh part!)

Our new favourite Prosecco producer, this wine is incredibly drinkable and will appeal to the palate of Prosecco aficionados as well as those after a decent glass of fizz.

Champagne Cuvee Royale Brut, Joseph Perrier, Champagne, France

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut Champagne, so named for it was a favourite of Queen Victoria and King Edward VII, is a soft, smooth and ripe Champagne. Offering an easy balanced style with crisp floral fruit aromas including notes of apple and pear, it has a soft and refreshing aftertaste. This Champagne is the perfect apéritif.

Rose 75ml 125ml 175ml

2023 Whispering Angel Rose, D'Esclans, Provence, France

The Icon made by the highly skilled Sacha Lichine has beautiful aromas of rose petals, rhubarb and pomegranate leading the perfume. A sensual and succulent palate follows, topped with teasing, palate-pinching acidity.

2023 Organic Sauvignon Blanc/Verdejo, Mureda, La Mancha, Spain £2.50 £3.50 £5.00 Bright lemon in colour; fresh and fruity aromas; crisp citrus flavours this organic certified wine has a pleasingly fruity finish.

2022 French Ambush Viognier, Domaine de Cabrials, Languedoc, France £3.65 £5.10 £6.00 A chic and classy Viognier, floral on the nose with white flower and lily notes. Its full and round on the palate, nicely balanced with a lasting finish. An elegant, fine and refreshing white wine full of French 'joie de vivre'.

2023 Watervale Riesling, Jim Barry, Clare Valley, South Australia

£3.80 £5.25 £6.1

Mouthwatering aromas of lemon, grapefruit juice, lime and white flowers combine with a lick of mineral, wet slate. Refreshing and intense, the generosity of flavour shows all the hallmarks of Watervale Riesling, perfectly balanced by zesty acidity.

2022 Pinot Grigio, Tramin, Trentino Alto Adige, Italy

£3.80 £5.25 £6.15

This Pinot Grigio brings the alpine freshness factor to the glass! Rich, full and dry with expressive notes of ripe pear and peach complemented by floral hints. Delicate on the palate with a zesty citrus character layered with notes of pear and peach through to a long, persistent finish.

2022 BOB Short for Kate Sauvignon Blanc, Ben Glover Family Wines, Marlborough, New Zealand

This stunning Organic Sauvignon Blanc is made by one of the top New Zealand's top wine makers, Ben Glover and is an homage to his late sister, Kate. It is a zesty Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc offers the best of what the region has to offer. There are lovely aromas of white peach, melon and tropical fruits. Wonderful tastes of tropical passion fruit, guava and mandarin on the palate as well as a mouth-watering succulence and a delightful persistence.

2023 Kidnappers Chardonnay, Craggy Range, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand £5.90 £8.50 £9.50 The evocatively named Kidnapper's Chardonnay takes its name from Hawke's Bay's dramatic headland of Cape Kidnappers. It is made with grapes grown at Te Awanga, where the cool coastal breezes enhance Chardonnay's acidity and fresh flavours, translating here to a medium-bodied, crisp style with ripe peach aromas and complex layered aromas of cedar and spice. This is Craggy Range's answer to Chardonnay from Chablis.

2022 Chablis 'Ses Enfants', Le Domaine d''Henri, Burgundy, France £6.50 £9.50 £11.50 The wine expresses flint, herbal notes and citrus in the nose, classic traits of Chablis. Bright crisp acidity provides tension and backbone to the ripe flavors of melon, pear and almonds.

2022 Côtes du Rhône 'Parallèle 45', Paul Jaboulet Aîné, Rhône, France

£3.00 £5.00 £6.00

A blend of Grenache (53%), Syrah (37%), Mourvèdre (3%), Marselan (3%) and Carignan (2%) this cuvée represents Paul Jaboulet Aîné's commitment to organic viticulture and respect for natural balances. The nose is expressive and rich with aromas of ripe red fruit (strawberry, raspberry) combined with floral and spicy notes. On the palate, it has a fresh, delicious attack with good balance and supple tannins. Notes of red fruit carry through to the finish.

2022 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Viña Perez Cruz, Maipo Valley, Chile £4.00 £6.00 £7.00 This Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva from Perez Cruz is one of the most constantly excellent wines we have tried and becomes a firm favourite of anyone who tries it. So what does it taste like: It opens with aromas of cassis, black cherry and toasty oak leading to a palate that is spicy, complex, full-bodied and so deliciously rich.

2015 Rioja Gran Reserva, Bodegas Ondarre, Rioja, Spain

£4.75 £6.75 £7.75

Bodegas Ondarre makes exceptional value Rioja – it amazes us every time we drink their wines, how they can make wines of quality for these prices! This 2015 has a complex and mature bouquet that offers rich fruit aromas, along with hints of spice and notes of raisined fruit layered with tobacco and leather.

2022 Origin Pinot Noir, Saint Clair, Marlborough, New Zealand

This is a gorgeous Pinot Noir made from grapes grown across the Marlborough province. This Pinot Noir displays wonderful aromas of black and red cherries, forest fruits, strawberry conserve and spice.

2016 Bordeaux Supérieur, Château Lestrille Capmartin, Bordeaux, France £5.20 £7.20 £8.50 A medium-bodied Bordeaux showing concentrated fruit aromas backed by delicate woody notes. In the mouth is has good freshness, while the structure shows high-quality tannins.

2020 Merlot, Groot Constantia, Western Cape, South Africa

£5.90 £8.50 £9.50

Groot is a famous winery and this Merlot is a special drop! Rich and ripe delivering aromas of sun-ripened plum, mocha and dark chocolate enveloped in delicate hints of oak spice, tobacco and cinnamon. The palate of ripe black fruits and subtle oak are framed by firm tannins through to a lingering finish.

2021 Malbec DOC De Sangre, Luigi Bosca, Mendoza, Argentina

£6.00 £8.95 £9.95

The Luigi Bosca Malbec 2021 is a classic expression of the renowned Malbec varietal from Mendoza, In the glass it has a deep and bright red violet wine with balanced aromas and red fruit and sweet spice notes. It is refreshing and voluptuous in the mouth, with fine and gentle tannins, while it is clean and expressive in the palate, with a strong character, typicity and a deep finish with soft smoked hues as a result of its ageing in oak barrels.

2021 Bishop Shiraz, Glaetzer, Barossa Valley, Australia

£7.50 £10.50 £12.50

Bishop is a true expression of Barossa Shiraz that is elegantly structured with a long finish. Made from exceptional old vine fruit was sourced from the famed Ebenezer sub district at the northern tip of the Barossa Valley. These old vines are between 35-120 years old. In the glass there is an explosion of brooding dark tones with bright cassis and coffee bean hints. The palate has a subtle richness with flavours of dark plum and blackberry intermingled with dark chocolate and dried spice. Generous yet restrained tannin provides exceptional palate length and persistence.

2021 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine de la Solitude, Rhône Valley, France £8.00 £12.00 £16.00 Domaine de la Solitude's wines are renowned for their characteristic elegance whilst expressing the true origins of their terroir. This 2021 is a rich and opulent wine with ripe blackcurrant aromas layered with notes of the garrigue and cistus (a hardy shrub) flowers. Full-bodied but with a soft texture on the palate; this wine retains the estate's characteristic elegance whilst embracing a modern style of winemaking. Ripe fruits combine with notes of cocoa and cherry and a hint of liquorice on the finish.

Port75ml125mlAlta No. 10' Ten-Year-Old Tawny Port, Quinta da Pedra Alta£9.00£12.00

Alta No.10 is an elegant, luscious, complex Tawny Port made in traditional granite lagars and aged in old casks. Great with cheese!
